I. God's Irrefutable Title To Property Or Ownership

PROPERTY

Webster's 1828

- The exclusive right of possessing, enjoying and disposing of a thing; ownership.
- *Prior occupancy* of land and of wild animals gives to the possessor the property of them.
- The *labor of inventing, making, or producing* any thing constitutes one of the highest and one of the indefeasible titles to property.
- Property is also acquired by inheritance, by gift, or by purchase.
- Property is sometimes held in common, yet each man's right to his share is exclusively his own.
